

2022 PRIMARY ELECTION VOTING OPTIONS

1) MAIL- IN ABSENTEE BALLOT (EXCUSE REQUIRED)

April 2 - May 3, 2022. Application to cast a mail-in absentee ballot must be made through the online portal at www.govote.ky.gov. The applicant must meet one of the following requirements:

- Unable to appear due to age, disability or illness
- A member of the Armed Forces confined to a military base
- A spouse or dependent of a member of the Armed Forces
- A student who temporarily resides outside of the county in which they are registered
- Temporarily reside outside the state, but are eligible to vote in Kentucky
- Person who is incarcerated and charged but not yet convicted of a crime
- Person whose employment location requires them to be absent from the county all hours and all days that excuse and no-excuse absentee voting is conducted
- Person qualified under the address confidentiality program with the Secretary of State office

Mail-In Ballot may be returned by mail with \$1.36 postage or placed in a dropbox located at the Henderson County Courthouse inside on the 2nd floor or outside off the Elm Street entrance.

2) IN-HOUSE ABSENTEE (EXCUSE REQUIRED) - Co. Clerk's Office, Courthouse

May 4 - May 11, 2022. Application to cast an absentee ballot can be made during the six business days prior to the Thursday on which no-excuse Early voting occurs. The applicant must meet one of the following conditions not allowing them to appear at the polls on Election Day and on the no-excuse Early voting days:

- Unable to appear due to age, disability, or illness
- A resident of Kentucky and a qualified voter but absent from the county on Election Day
- Having surgery or has a spouse who is having surgery
- Temporarily resides outside the state, but still eligible to vote in this state
- A member of the Armed Forces confined to a military base
- A woman in her last trimester of pregnancy and completes a sworn statement
- A student who temporarily resides outside of the county in which they are registered
- An employed person scheduled to work during the poll hours of 6 a.m. to 6 p.m.
- An election officer for the current election cycle

3) MEDICAL EMERGENCY - Co. Clerk's Office, Courthouse

May 4 – May 17, 2022. Voter or voter's spouse, parent, children, sibling, niece, nephew or designee, may apply for an absentee ballot. Emergency condition must have occurred within 14-days prior to Election Day.

4) EARLY IN-PERSON VOTING (NO EXCUSE REQUIRED) - Archery Center Thursday, May 12- Saturday, May 14. 8 AM – 4 PM each day

5) Election Day – May 17 Any registered eligible voter can vote at any of the following locations:

- *Chase Fulcher Archery Center
- *JFK Community Center
- *Bend Gate Elementary School
- *Spottsville Elementary School
- *Niagara Elementary School
- *AB Chandler Elementary School

Please note if you are registered as anything other than a Republican or Democrat you are not eligible to vote due to no NON-PARTISAN ballot this election.
