CASEY'S LAW CHECKLIST

After leaving the Henderson County Attorney's Office, you will need to

- Contact a Physician to schedule an evaluation
- Contact a Qualified Health Professional to schedule an evaluation. (Nicole Frields at the WARM Center (270) 826-0036 can do these evaluations free of charge.)
- Contact a Drug/Alcohol Abuse Center, check availability of bed/space and if the facility will take your insurance. As the petitioner **YOU WILL BE RESPONSIBLE** for paying for the treatment.

Once the Petition for Casey Law is filed, you will be notified of the date of the first court hearing with the Judge.

1st hearing- Testimony from the Petitioner (Respondent doesn't have to be there). Petitioner needs to have the evaluations dates for the Judge.

2nd hearing- Petitioner has to have both evaluation reports completed, and have the name and address of the facility where the Respondent will be transported.
